As well as building their skills across all subjects this term, the children will be developing their independence and resilience on our residential trip to Boreatton Park in October.

English

In English, we will be reading 'A Kind of Spark'. Using this text, we will be exploring a range of different skills and techniques to develop our writing.

We will be considering audience and purpose for different text types, including a character description, non-chronological report and a balanced argument.



Maths

The focus in Maths this term will be:

- Number and place value (up to ten million)
- Four operations (including the order of operations)
 - Comparing and ordering fractions
 - Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions
 - Converting units of measure

<u>Science</u>

In Science this half-term, we are looking at 'Classifying Critters'. We will describe how living things are classified into groups based on their similar observable characteristics.

Next half-term, we are exploring the human circulatory system, describing the functions of the heart, blood and blood vessels.

<u>Topic</u>

Our topics this term are 'Ancient Maya' (History) and 'South America' (Geography). The children will locate regions of Central and South America, looking at how it has changed over time. They will discover who the Maya were and what their beliefs were.



P.E.

P.E. will take place on a **Tuesday** and **Friday** for both classes. Please could children attend school in their P.E. kit on these days. This term we will develop skills in tag rugby, dodgeball, football and basketball.

Children will also have regular French (Autumn 1), R.E. (Autumn 2), Computing, Music and PSHE lessons.

Homework and Spellings

- Homework will continue to be set on **Fridays** and completed no later than the following **Wednesday**. Maths homework will be set on MyMaths with all other tasks going home in homework books.
- Spellings for each week will go live on Spelling Shed each **Friday** to be learnt and then tested at home the following week.
